### REQUIRED SPECIFICATIONS SAMPLE LANGUAGE

The Performance Work Statement (PWS) should: a) specify that contractor-furnished supplies meet the recycled content requirements set forth by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), b) specify that the contractor will use recycled content (paper products, signage, etc.) for contractor-furnished supplies, and c) provide a [LINK to the list of EPA-designated recycled content products](#).

Sample Language:

*The contractor shall maximize the use of recycled content products in the execution of this contract, to include paper products, signage and other materials that are associated with contract tasks. Particular attention will be given to designated products that appear on the Environmental Protection Agency's recycled content products list.*

*The website [www.epa.gov/smm/comprehensive-procurement-guideline-cpg-program](http://www.epa.gov/smm/comprehensive-procurement-guideline-cpg-program) will be consulted when identifying designated Environmental Protection Agency recycled content products.*



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### REQUIRED SPECIFICATIONS SAMPLE LANGUAGE (CONTINUED)

The PWS should: a) specify that the contractor meet the BioPreferred Program requirements set forth by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), b) specify individual products that the contractor will ensure contain biobased content (disposable containers, disposable cutlery, cleaning products, etc.) for all contractor-furnished supplies, and c) provide a [LINK to the list of USDA -designated product categories](#).

Sample Language:

*The contractor shall maximize the use of biobased products in the execution of this contract, to include disposable containers, disposable cutlery, cleaning products and other materials that are associated with contract tasks. Particular attention will be given to designated products that appear on the USDA BioPreferred products list.*

*The website [www.biopreferred.gov/BioPreferred/faces/catalog/Catalog.xhtml](http://www.biopreferred.gov/BioPreferred/faces/catalog/Catalog.xhtml) will be consulted when identifying designated USDA BioPreferred products.*

The PWS should: a) specify the use of energy efficient food service equipment and appliances, b) specify individual products that the contractor will ensure meet energy efficiency requirements (dishwashers, ovens, fryers, refrigerators, etc.) for all contractor-furnished equipment, and c) provide a [LINK to the list of Department of Energy -covered product categories](#).

Sample Language:

*The contractor shall maximize the use of energy efficient products in the execution of this contract, to include dishwashers, ovens, fryers, refrigerators and other materials that are associated with contract tasks. Particular attention will be given to designated products that appear on the Department of Energy's products list.*

*The website <https://energy.gov/eere/femp/search-energy-efficient-products> will be consulted when identifying designated Department of Energy -covered products.*

The PWS should specify that all deliverables be printed double-sided on paper that contains post-consumer fiber (recycled content).

### OTHER SPECIFICATIONS, IF APPLICABLE

- Low or non-toxic or hazardous chemicals
- Use of chemicals and products that do not contain ozone-depleting substances (ODS). Note that if FAR Clause 53.223-11 is included, it does not indicate compliance with sustainability requirements. This clause requires contractors to label products with ODS but does not address the use of alternatives.
- Use of biobased products for equipment maintenance and cleaning
